ER Updates for 2008-2009

INFOhio's Core Collection of Electronic Resources will see some changes for the 2008-2009 school year. One change, **a new username and password for home access**, was announced earlier this month and will be effective July 1, 2008.

The username and password for [INFOhio's Core Collection of Electronic Resources](#) will be changing for the 2008-2009 school year. We know some schools are already preparing orientation materials and other handouts for next school year. **The new username/password will go live on July 1, 2008.**

The 2008-2009 username/password was distributed to visitors to the [INFOhio booth at the eTech Ohio conference](#) and has been posted to our *All Librarians* distribution lists. The new username/password is also available from your [NOECA](#).

The username and password may be included in handbooks, newsletters and other printed materials that go only to teachers, students and/or their parents. Due to the license agreements, the username/password may **NOT** be published where it would be available to the general public. Therefore, it cannot be posted on any district, building or library Web page that is publicly accessible. It cannot be included in any publications, written or electronic, that are distributed to your entire community. Doing any of the above is considered a violation of INFOhio's licensing agreements and can result in the loss of access to any or all resources.

The current username and password will continue to function through September 15, 2008. This transition period will allow our users to continue to reap the wealth of information available through the Core Collection without interruption during the summer months.

New username/password bookmark masters and other support materials will be available from the INFOhio Web site's [Toolkit](#) no later than July 31. The password for protected documents has been distributed to educators through the *All Librarians* distribution lists.

INFOhio's *Core Collection of Electronic Resources* will see more changes for the 2008-2009 school year than a new username and password.

Several of the Collection's products will be new, replacing current resources. The changes will be effective July 1, 2008.

In one of the most significant changes to the Core Collection, **World Book Web Complete Suite** will replace the set of products currently provided by Encyclopaedia Britannica Corp. (*Annals of American History*, *Britannica Online School Edition*, *Enciclopedia Juvenil*, *Enciclopedia Universal en Español* and *World Data Analyst*).

Highlights of **World Book Web Complete Suite** include *World Book Kids*, *World Book Online Reference Center*, *World Book Research Tools Edition* and *World Book Advanced*. Spanish and French encyclopedias are part of the **Suite**, *Enciclopedia Estudiantil Hallazgos* and *L'Encyclopedie Decouverte*.

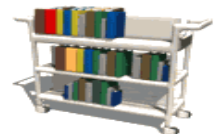
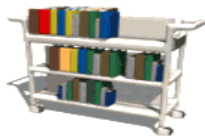

- **Generate list of items w/ XX Call numbers**
From the INFOhio report tab, select the **“CAT: Shelflist” (catitemlist)** report. Specify a Call Number Range of x – xxx (>x<xxx). This report will only list XX call numbers if there are items associated with the XX call number record.

- **Titles without copies**
From the All Titles report tab, select the **“List Titles with No Copies” (titlesnocopies)** report. A default library will be selected, but consider clearing this selection to generate a list for all libraries. Sort the list by call number so those with XX call numbers are near the end of the report. This report lists all call numbers that have no item information attached.

- **Review list of Missing items** (should be done before inventory so items can be moved from “Missing” to “Discard” by ITC Staff). From the All Inventory report tab, select the **“PreInv 1) MISSING Copies List”** report. A default library will be selected, but consider clearing this selection to generate a list for all libraries.

- **REPORTS / INFOHIO: Update Expiration Dates on Patrons**
Review the list of patrons to expire 7/1/08 or before and update the expiration dates accordingly with the anticipated graduation date (or NEVER if the anticipated expiration date is not known).

- **Suspend LISTSERV emails**
 - Start at the INFOhio home page, www.infohio.org.
 - Click on "About INFOhio."
 - Select "E-Lists" from the left menu.
 - Select the appropriate E-List from the top section to "Join or leave the ...list."
 - Enter the e-mail address by which you are subscribed or search by your surname.
 - Click on the appropriate button.
