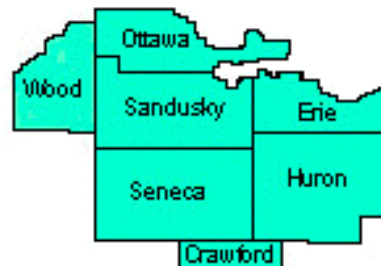

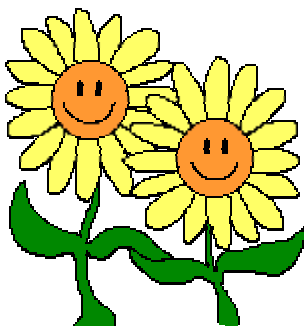
### INFOhio Annual Retreat Powering up for Transitions
