

DASL Printer Specifications

DASL generates mostly PDF files for reports. Any printer or networked copier machine that can correctly print a PDF file within the amount of time that is acceptable to the user and with the clarity they desire will work. The other printing needed will be the DASL web pages.

We are intentionally not listing any printer manufacturers, brands, or models and don't have any intention of doing so because one of the design goals in DASL was to not be tied to any one specific type of printer and give the schools the flexibility to use the hardware they had invested in for other purposes.

The choice of printer is the district's decision based on what type of printer they want for printing word processing documents, spreadsheets, PDF files, web pages, etc. Districts will need to decide how much they want to spend and the volume/quality they expect from the printer.
